In his book "Velvet Elvis", Rob Bell quotes a Jewish proverb "May you be covered by the dust of your rabbi". The quote is based on the religious training of ancient Judaism. All Jewish boys took part in religious training as children, but most ended up working in their family business. The brightest of the bright would apply to become a disciple of a well-known rabbi. These disciples would devote their lives to learning from their master, with their ultimate goal to become like their master. They would follow their master so closely that they would be covered by the dust from his feet, thus the quote "may you be covered by the dust of your rabbi."

Whose dust covers you? Do you spend so much time with Christ that others can see Him when they look at you? That's the goal, but is that goal becoming a reality in your life?

It's easy to minimize Christ. It's easy to limit Christ to a few hours on Sunday morning. It's easy to give Christ pieces of your life without giving him your entire life. That kind of relationship will never transform your marriage, your family, your relationships, your values . . . simply put, that kind of relationship will never transform you.

My prayer for you, for me, and for Beechland is simple . . . may we all be covered by the dust of our Savior.

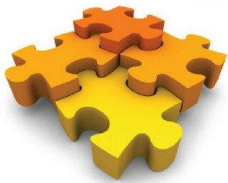
