## From Our Counseling Ministry...

If someone you love is suffering from depression there are three things that they must avoid and you can help: isolation, sleep problems (too little or too much), and lack of physical activity.

1. Isolation leaves a person vulnerable to negative thinking with no one to counter these false beliefs and in the spiritual realm they are a target of the lies of the Enemy. Spend time with them listening and talking with them.
2. Sleep disturbances can cause problems with their ability to think clearly and to have the energy to fight back against despair. Encourage your loved one to see their doctor or a psychiatrist.

Physical activity is being proven over and over in research to benefit any emotional trauma. Some studies recently released have even shown exercise to be *more* beneficial than antidepressants in treating depression. Make a regular "walking date" or find another activity the two of you can enjoy together. Beechland has wonderful exercise facilities that you can take advantage of.

Above all, never give up on them! If two weeks go by and you don't see their mood lifting please refer them to us at the Counseling Ministry. We are here to help.
